

# Tiles on jacks

## Definition

Flooring consisting of natural stone tiles laid on adjustable jacks.

On the exterior, the joints between tiles remain open to allow rainwater to drain away. Joints should be at least 1 cm wide.

## Choice of flooring

The thickness and the format of the tiles must be determined according to the permanent loads, service loads and the resistance of the stone. Resistance to wear must be compatible with the conditions of use and its frost resistance sufficient for outdoor use (see standard XP B10-601).

In order to facilitate installation, it is recommended that tile thickness be adjusted on the parts of the tile which are in contact with the jack.
